HISTORIC WACO FIELD

We will be returning to Troy Oh. for the Strawberry Festival but at a different venue. Camping dates will be May 31 thru June 3. We will be camping at the WACO airfield on route 25A in Troy. This will be dry camping for a nightly fee of only \$5. Waco Field is being developed by the Waco Historical Society which is currently restoring the airfield complex. For the past 20 years the society has been preserving the history of the famed aircraft. A new hanger has been erected housing several historic aircraft and a gift shop. Tours of the museum will be available We will be parking along the 2200 ft runway on a firm gravel area. 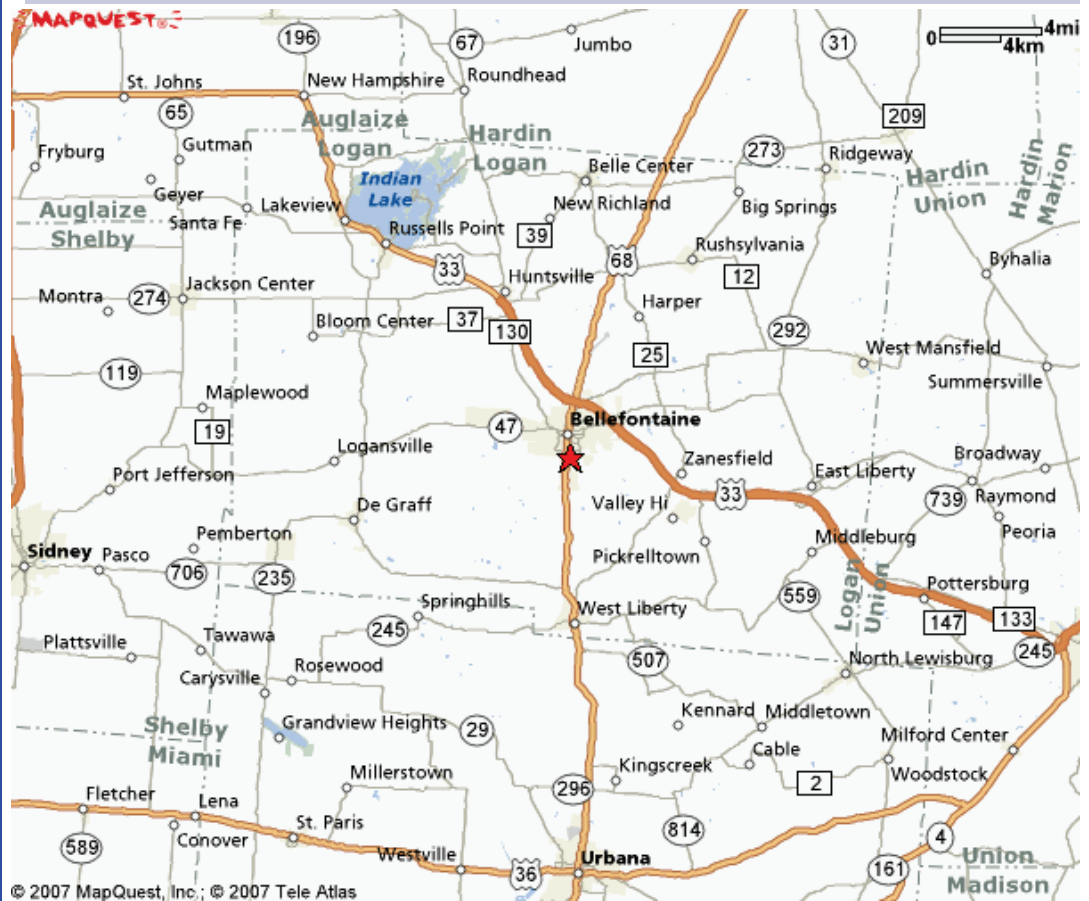

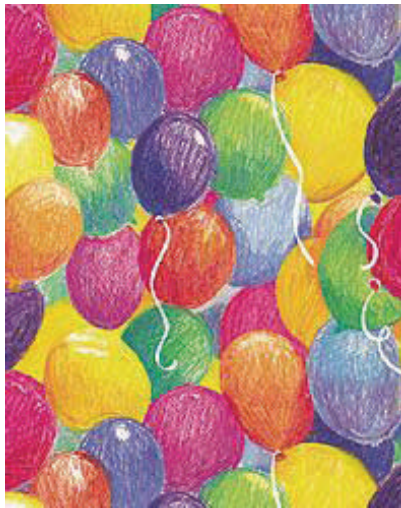

Are Due

- From the North...** Travel South on US Rt 68 into Bellefontaine. At the Fairgrounds on your left, turn into the main Fairgrounds entrance. It is about 1.2 miles South of the Bellefontaine Square.
- From the South...** Travel North on US Rt 68 into Bellefontaine, just past Lake Avenue turn right into the Fairgrounds main entrance. This is 1.1 miles North of Wal-Mart
- From the East...** Travel West on State Rt 47 into Bellefontaine. State Rt. 47 will end and connect with US Rt 68 in town. Travel South on US Rt 68 thru Bellefontaine
At the Fairgrounds on your left, turn into the main Fairgrounds entrance. It is about 1.2 miles South of the Bellefontaine Square.
- From the West...** Travel East on State Rt 47 into Bellefontaine. Turn right on St Rt 68 at the fire station. Travel South on US Rt 68 thru Bellefontaine. At the Fairgrounds on your left, turn into the main Fairgrounds entrance. It is about 1.2 miles South of the Bellefontaine Square.
