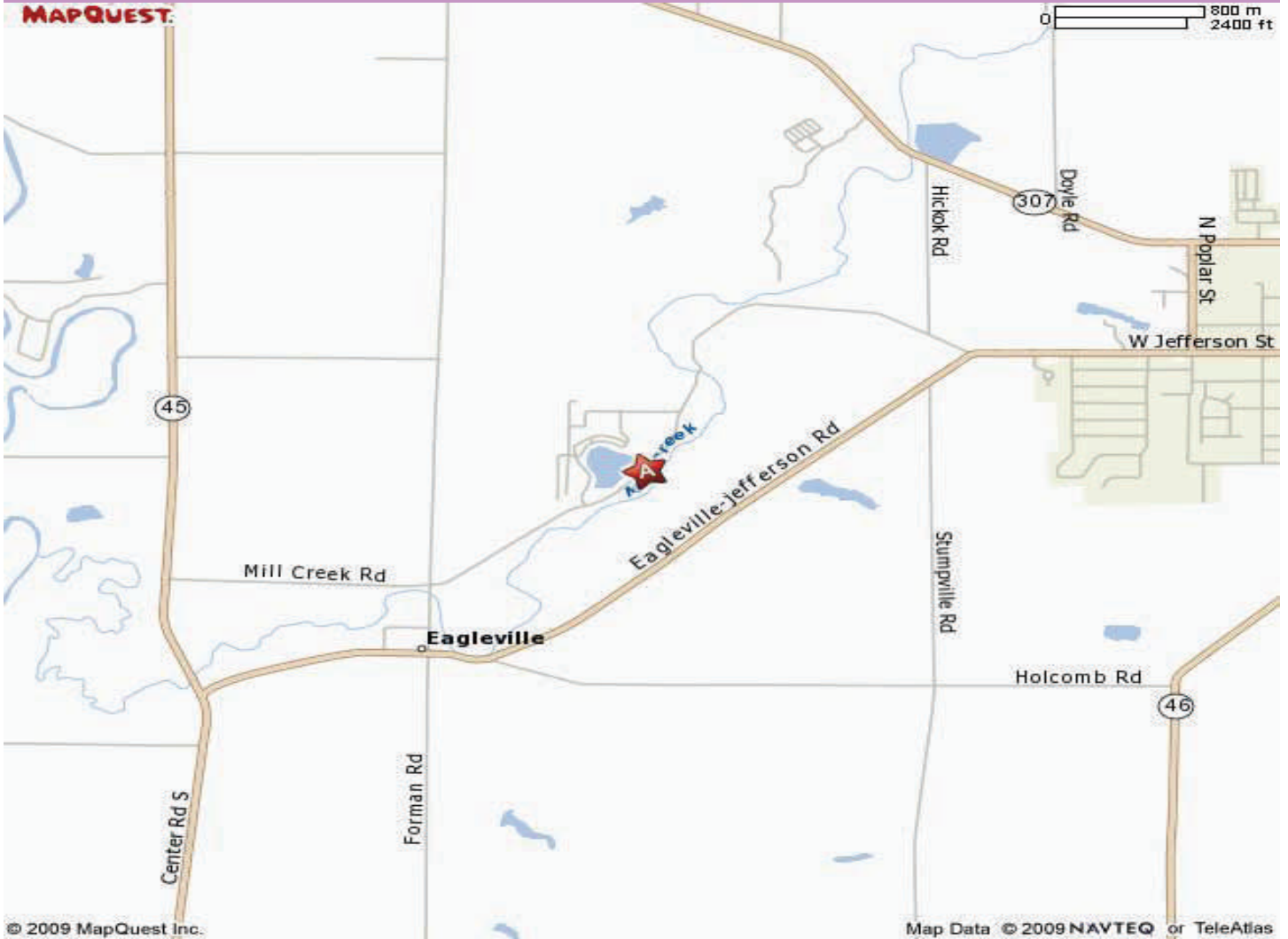
## In our Thoughts

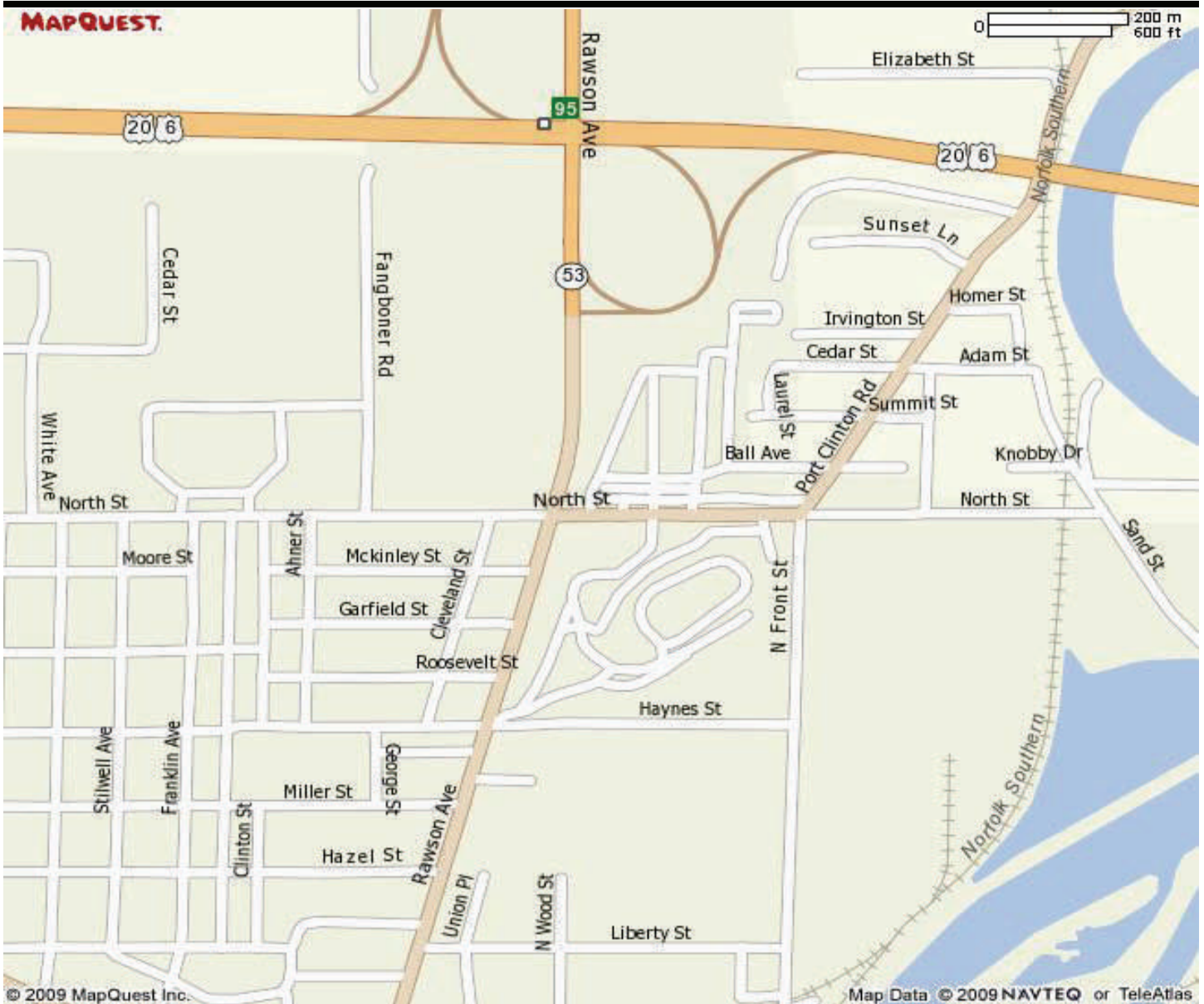


**From the west—I—90**
