ROSS COUNTY RALLY JULY 19-21 CHILlicothe OHIO

The Outdoor Drama Tecumseh!

The July rally will be held in Chillicothe at the Ross County Fairgrounds. Chillicothe was the first capital of the state of Ohio so there are lots of historic sites to visit in the area. Also this was a major settlement for the Hopewell Mound builders and there is a large site called Mound City just a few miles from the fairgrounds. <http://www.nps.gov/hocu/index.htm>

On Friday at 8:30, during breakfast, Kyrsten Vogel, executive director of the convention and visitors bureau will speak to us about all there is to see. Following this you will be on your own to visit the sites of your choice. We have also set up a golf outing if you are interested. Please include number of people who wish to go on your reservation.



At 3:30 we will caravan to the Tecumseh site to have a behind the scenes tour of the outdoor drama. This tour costs \$3.50 per person. The tour begins promptly at 4:00 and is about an hour long. When we return we will have finger food in the JVS building.

On Saturday you will be on your own until 5:30 when we will gather for a dinner of Pizza and salad and dessert (provided). We will caravan to Tecumseh at 6:45. Tecumseh is an outdoor drama about the life story of the Shawnee leader as he struggles to defend his sacred homelands in the Ohio country during the late 1700's. <http://www.tecumseh-drama.com/> **Bring your insect repellent.**

On Sunday, we will caravan to the Golden Corral for breakfast. You will pay at the door. The business meeting will be held at this time.

There is a new road, just opened this spring that is not on any map. It is Rt. 207 from Rt. 23 to Rt. 104. This road cuts across from Rt 23 to the south side of the fairgrounds. From State Route 23 take Rt 207 west to Rt 104 and turn right. The fairgrounds are on the right.

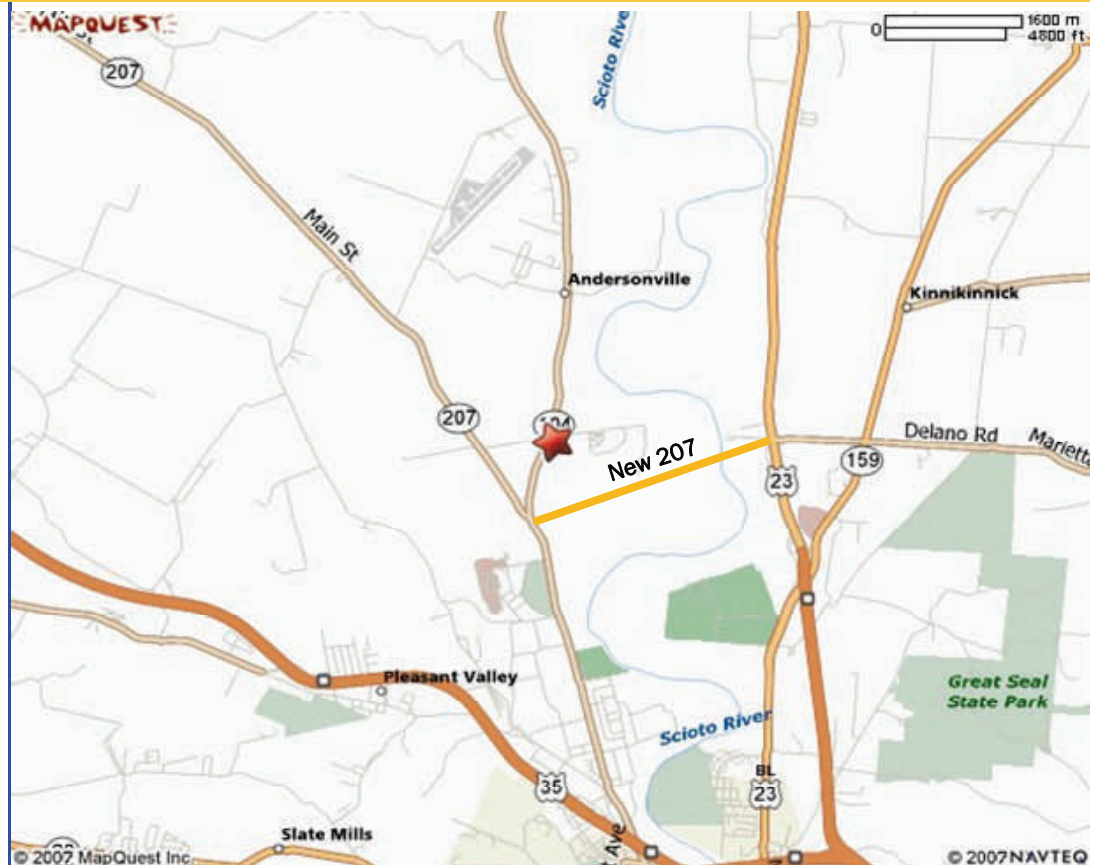
