SECRETARY'S REPORT

Secretary's Report Holland, MI May 6, 2009 7:00 pm

The meeting was called to order by President, Kent Copeland after a prayer by Paul Carr. Mary Alice Gast presented a correction to the minutes from October. This motion was accepted by Bill Nesbitt and seconded by Waneta Manos. Motion carried. Gast reported that we have 123 member coaches to date. Ernie Howard motioned that the minutes of the October meeting be accepted as printed. Mel Boerger seconded. Motion carried. Gast presented a participation award from FMCA for the chapter fair in Perry, GA. She said we will participate at the chapter fair at the GLASS Rally. 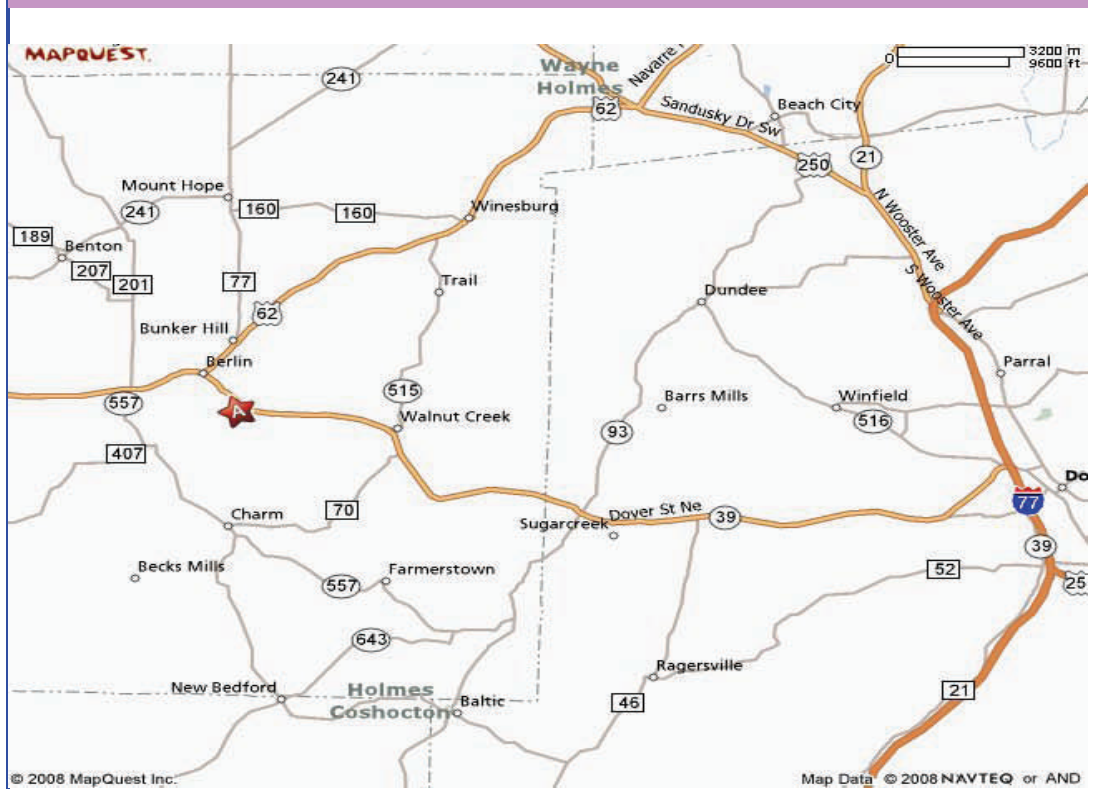

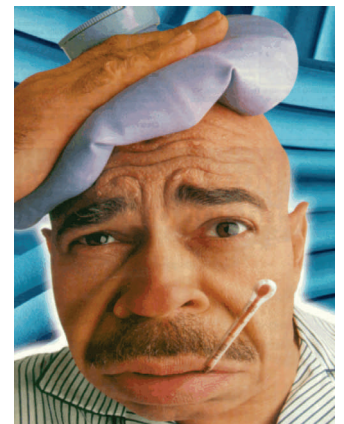
