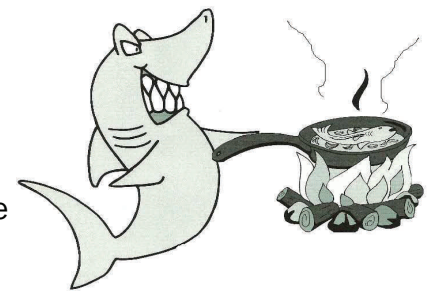

More details and rally reservation form will be in next month's Scope Ohio.

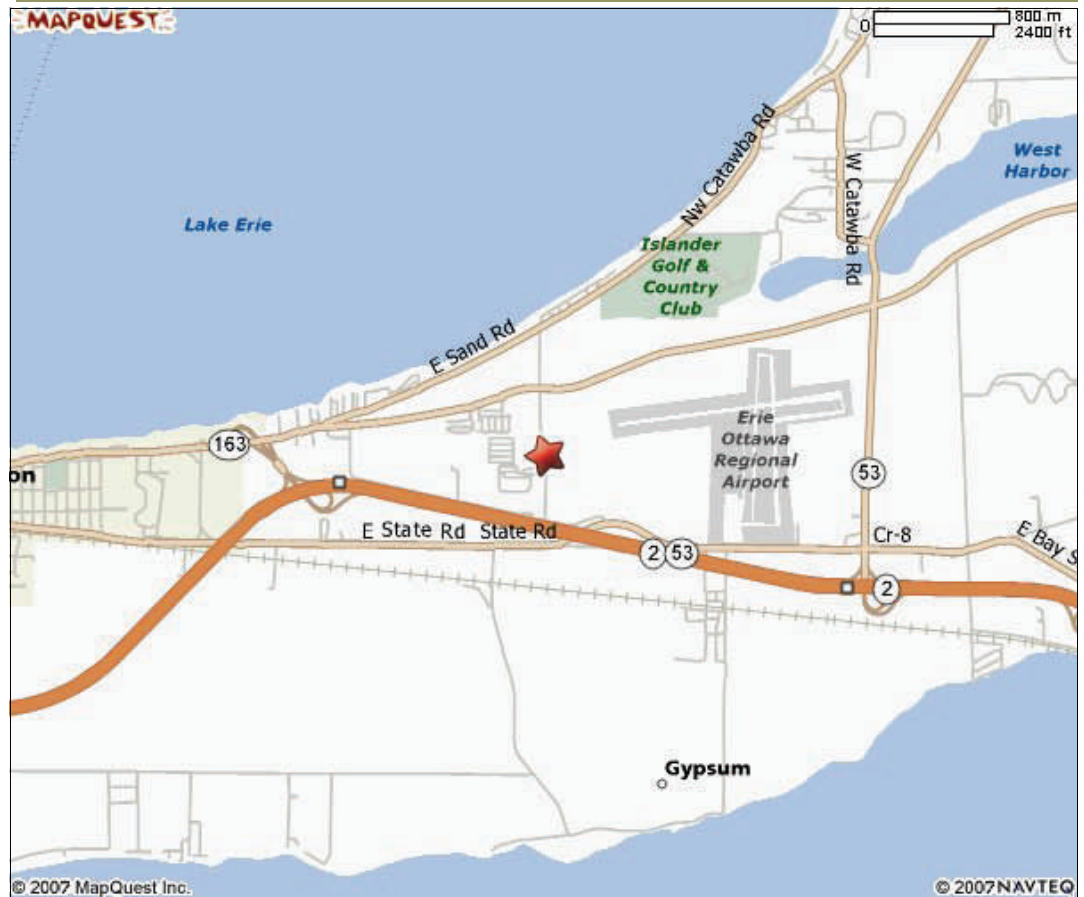
