We are both natives of Auglaize County, Ohio, and both from German ancestry. From 1989 through 2004 we attended approximately 60 NASCAR races, all but one or two of them with our 1989 Holiday Rambler Alumalite trailer, which we had for 23 years. Linda retired in 2012 after 41 years as a registered nurse at Joint Township District Memorial Hospital in St. Marys, and I retired in 2013 from the New Knoxville Telephone Company after 37 years. 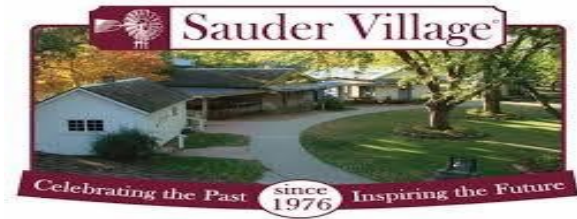
