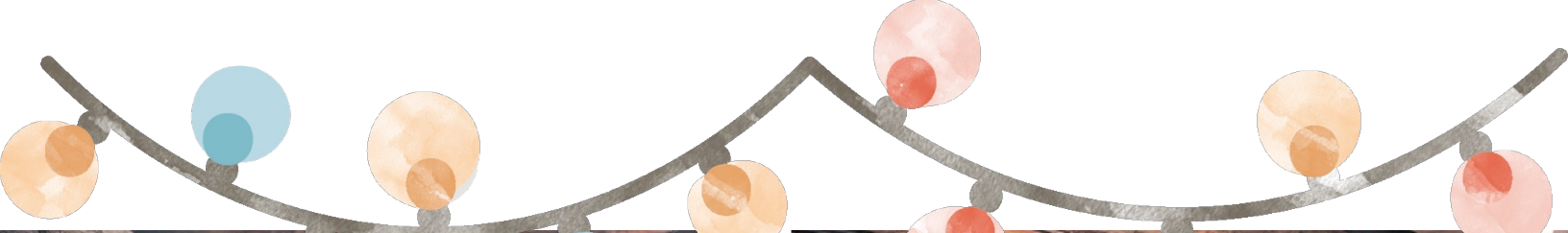


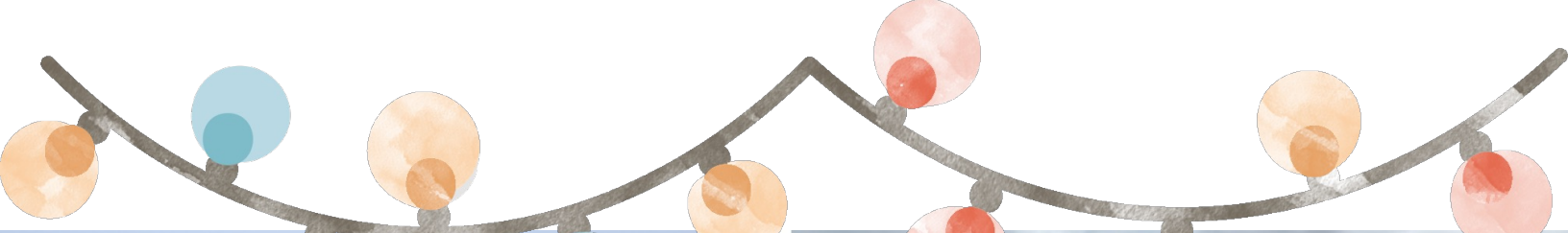












# Railroad Pie

## Ingredients

- 2 lbs ground beef
- 1 medium orange bell pepper, diced
- 1 medium yellow onion, diced
- 1 (10oz) can rotel tomatoes, mild
- 1 (10oz) can tomato soup
- 1 (14oz) can cream style corn
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp onion powder
- Sour cream topping

## Cornbread Topping

- 1 (8.5oz) box Jiffy cornbread muffin mix
- 1 large egg
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1 (14oz) can cream style corn
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese

## Instructions

- 1.Preheat the oven to 400 degrees.
- 2.In a large (12 inch) cast iron skillet over medium high heat brown up ground beef & soften bell pepper and onion together. Drain off excess grease.
- 3.Stir in rotel, tomato soup, cream corn, broth, salt, black pepper, garlic powder, and onion powder. Allow to simmer over medium heat for 15 minutes.
- 4.In a medium bowl whisk or stir together cornbread muffin mix, egg, milk, cream corn, and cheddar cheese. Pour mixture on top of the meat mixture in the cast iron skillet or baking dish.
- 5.Bake in a 400 degree preheated oven for 20–25 minutes until golden brown and cornbread is cooked through. Let sit for 10 minutes or so.
- 6.Serve HOT with a spoon of sour cream.

Our 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter financial report spans the 3-month period from Apr 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023. The majority of income in this report is fees collected from our May and July rallies. The only expenditure for this quarter is for payment of badges for our newest members.

As of the last bank reconciliation effort, our checkbook and quicken data is in agreement with the bank balance. While it appears that we had a substantial ending balance, a significant amount was used up in July for rally fees and our commitment to our National Director. Regardless, we are in good shape financially and our operating funds as of this report is \$3,837.18.

Meeting of the Ohio Nomads     July 15, 2023     Sauder Village     Archbold, OH

President, Denny Edgar opened the meeting by thanking the DelSorbo's for a great rally. The minutes were reported in the Scope after our last meeting as was the treasurer's report which was filed for audit.

Denny turned the meeting over to Tony DelSorbo, our treasurer.

Tony reported that we have 43 members, two of which are life members. Our current dues structure is not enough to support our club. We must keep a balance of \$3000 in the Fifth Third account to avoid monthly charges. We pay out \$120 for our website which is [www.ohionomads.com](http://www.ohionomads.com) and \$400 to our National Director, Bev Garcia, for her attendance at the FMCA National Rally. This year that rally is in Gillette, Wyoming in August.

Tony asked for suggestions from the floor. These included: increase dues, reinstate the 50/50 raffle, look at a different bank or credit union, increase cost of a new membership, and starting a Facebook page. It was decided to leave the new member costs the same at \$35. Gast has raffle tickets for the next rally.

A motion was made by Gloria Sluder to raise the annual dues to \$20 per year for 2024 and seconded by Mary Alice Gast. Motion carried. The current dues are \$10 per year. Most other clubs pay \$20 per year.

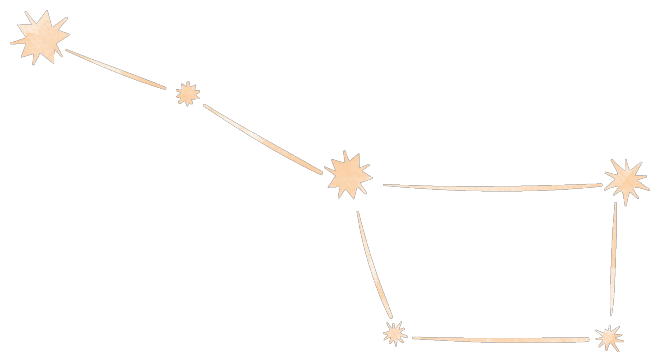

Tony mentioned that \$239 was donated to the Shriner's Hospital in Cincinnati last year. This donation is funded from Sheriff's money, the 50/50 raffle, and donations from members. Bob Gast suggested that these donations from members continue this year and Tony suggested that a donation could be included in the check when you pay your dues.

President Edgar adjourned the meeting.
