# Ingredients

- 5 cups watermelon cubed
- 2 cups strawberries sliced
- 1 cup cherries seed removed & sliced
- 1 cup raspberries
- · 1 cup blueberries
- juice of 1 lime
- 1 tablespoon agave syrup you can also use maple syrup or honey instead
- · few mint leaves chopped for garnish
- · chia seeds for garnish
- organic sugar for extra sweetness, 100% optional

# **Instructions**

- 1. In a big bowl or a plate, combine 5 cups of chopped watermelon, 2 cups of sliced strawberries, 1 cup of sliced cherries, 1 cup of raspberries, and 1 cup of blueberries.
- 2. Using a little bowl mix together the juice of 1 lime and 1 tablespoon agave syrup. Pour the dressing over the fruit salad. Sprinkle with chia seeds and chopped mint. Enjoy!
