Minimum of 8 people. Next



OHIO NOMADS TREASURER QUARTERLY REPORT

Our 4th quarter financial report spans the 3-month period from Jul 1, 2024 through Sep 30, 2024. The majority of income in this report is from fees collected for our August rally at Lively Lady, which was well attended and we all had a great time. That income, and that collected in previous months, was expended on campground and food expenses for the rally.

We also started to take in Nomads renewal dues this quarter and we're well ahead of schedule. Thankfully, our members are also renewing early as you can see by the dues collected. And, this quarter we have one new member family (welcome Larry and Brenda Kinnett).

We went into this quarter with a very low allocation for our annual charity. Thanks to Bob Gast for his motivating speech at Lively Lady, as well as your generosity from gifts received with your dues via mail, we were able to raise an additional \$180. This wallowed us to increase our charitable contribution to \$215, for which I wrote a check in late September and sent that to the Shriners Children's Ohio. Thank you all for making this happen!

As of the last bank reconciliation effort, our checkbook and quicken data are in agreement with the bank balance. Regardless, we are in good shape financially and our operating funds total as of this report is \$4,137.44 with no outstanding debts (although I

am expecting, likely in October, an invoice for \$28 to pay for our newest members' badges).
